The growing world of ECCP matchmaking

In only three months ECCP organized four matchmaking events and the numbers are impressive: more than 160 European cluster organisations and 40 SMEs were engaged in more than 1.100 bilateral meetings with counterparts from [Brazil](#), [Mexico](#), [Iran](#) and [Europe](#). Through the cluster organisations, it is estimated that the business opportunities identified and/or developed during the facilitated meetings can reach out to more than 15.000 European SMEs in various industrial sectors and across different value-chains.

For 2017, 5 more matchmaking events will be organized by the ECCP and its international partners, so follow closely their promotion on ECCP to secure your (funded) participation in one of them!

The Cluster Manager of the Year 2016 and EU Cluster Partnership 2016 elected at the European Cluster Conference

One of the highlights of the [2016 European Cluster Conference](#) (Brussels, 1-2/12/2016) was the Award Ceremony for the best **Cluster Manager of the Year** and for the excellence of a **EU Cluster Partnership** in promoting internationally the partnership's activities for the benefit of SMEs.



The winner of the audience vote was **Bianca Dragomir**, manager of [Valencian Region Renewable Energy Cluster \(AVAESEN\)](#) (Spain), who has become **the Cluster Manager of the Year 2016**. During her pitch, she explained how she had tried to "reinvent their cluster concept". The other shortlisted Cluster Manager candidates were **Marc Charlet**, from the French [Pôle de compétitivité MOVE'O](#), **Peter Simkens** from [DSP Valley](#) (Belgium) and **Georges Falessi**, from the French [Pôle de compétitivité Secured Communicating Solutions \(SCS\)](#). The **EU Cluster Partnership Award 2016** went to [Energy in Water \(EnW\)](#) represented by Pieter de Jong.

Cluster Achievements

The gift of imperfection or how AVAENSEN reinvented the cluster concept –the story behind Bianca Dragomir, the Cluster Manager of the Year 2016



The story behind the unusual approach of a cluster manager attempting to make a successful turnaround of a cluster surely caught the attention of the audience that voted for her as a worthy carrier of this prestigious title. So what is the story behind her cluster's achievement? Faced with the challenges of severe cutting in public subsidies for renewable energy projects due to the financial crisis, AVAENSEN needed to radically reinvent itself. In 2013 it transformed from a conventional public-private cluster organisation to a self-funded service-provider, raising the membership fee and widening offered services. By 2016, by working together with the Regional Government, AVAENSEN has liberated 15 huge "frozen" wind parks in the Region of Valencia, allocated more than 5 years ago through tenders to a small group of large multinationals but never actually built, blocking investments of more than 1 billion EUR. This wind capacity will be allocated to many small wind parks, acting as self-consumption hubs for small communities and predominantly built by SMEs.
