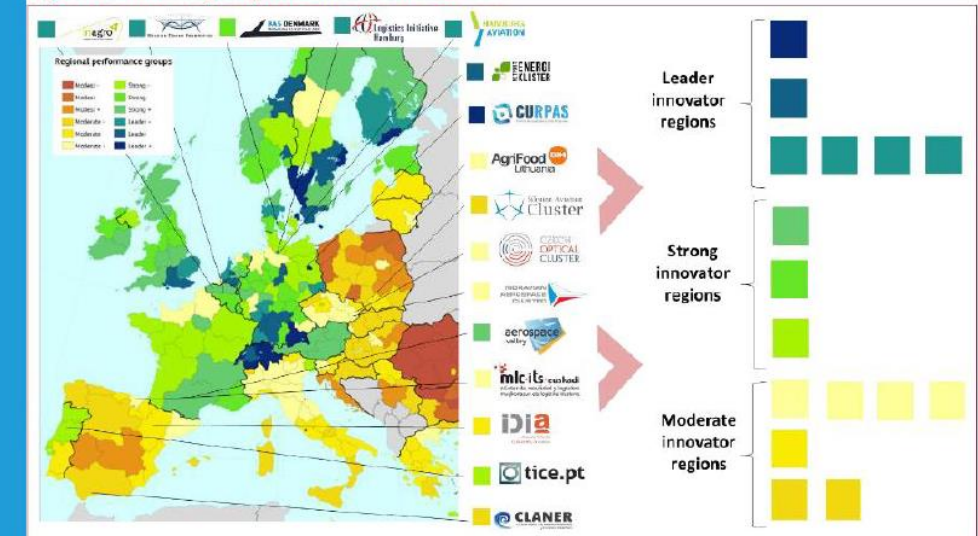
## InnoWing
