Cluster Go International call opened!

The main objective of the action is to intensify cluster and business network collaboration across European countries and also across sectoral boundaries and to support the establishment of European Strategic Cluster Partnerships-Going International (ESCP-4i) to lead international cluster cooperation in fields of strategic interest towards third countries beyond Europe and notably in support of the development of emerging industries.



The action will be implemented by consortia of cluster organisations or business network organisations operating in COSME participating countries that are interested in establishing and running a ESCP-4i partnership. These are expected to develop a joint 'European' strategic vision with a global perspective and common goals towards specific third markets.

If you want to develop a proposal and you are looking for partners to apply or you are looking to join a consortium active in the same domain as you, it is recommended to use [ECCP's Partner Search tool](#). 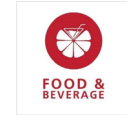

The [homepage of the ESCP-4i partnerships](#) was restructured and enriched with information, offering other clusters insights into the partnerships targeting markets beyond Europe. On the important issue of the sustainability strategy of international cluster collaboration after the end of the project, the ECCP organized a webinar for the Strand 2 partnerships about to enter into this phase. It was an excellent opportunity to openly discuss the pros and cons of various scenarios, and to learn from each other's experiences and backgrounds.

Cluster Achievements

ECCP celebrates its first anniversary!

In March 2016 the ECCP was re-launched with the objective of providing networking support for clusters organisations, and for their members to increase their competitiveness through the stimulation of trans-national and international cooperation. Our efforts were dedicated to attracting the cluster organisations and creating a cluster community through services covering their needs.

In one year, more than **550 cluster organisations**, **25 ESCP-4i partnerships**, **25 cluster networks** (territorial or sectorial), more than **29 EU cluster-related projects** were profiled. ECCP became an abundant information source with over **310 news**, **220 events**, **20 cluster achievements**, **50 calls for proposals**, and **30 partner search requests** published on the main pages. More than **400 news** and **190 events** were published/promoted by the users on their own cluster profiles and disseminated through the weekly digest.

The ECCP is dedicated to offering the cluster organisations community the best service according to its needs. For this two major [user satisfaction surveys](#) were undertaken and feedback monitored diligently, in order to adapt and improve the community's demand.

The second ECCP poll showed a high interest of users for webinars (91% participants were interested). Two webinars were held, one related to the Partner Search tool and one addressed to the ESCP-4i partnerships Strand 2.
