### 1<sup>st</sup> RESIST matchmaking event on Resilience for the European Automotive Industry

The Eurocluster RESIST, Resilience through sustainable processes and production for the European automotive industry, invites you to its first hybrid matchmaking event.

RESIST will release 1,05M€ to support European SMEs, 60,000 euros for each company, to improve their resilience in the five topics of the project, through vouchers and funding projects.

The topics are: Training, Networking, Go International, Adaptation and Innovation.

Enterprises, start-ups, technologists and other cluster members will explore business and innovation opportunities, counting with the professional support of the RESIST team, composed by representatives of the clusters Autoklastr (Czech Republic), CEAGA and IDiA (Spain), Mechatronics (Austria) and Pôle Véhicule du Futur (France).



## DESCRIPTION OF THE CITY AND PLACES OF INTEREST TO VISIT

**Zaragoza** is the capital city of Aragón, fifth more populated city in Spain. It is an important logistic point, 300km away from cities like Madrid, Barcelona, Valencia, Bilbao and Toulouse.

Zaragoza has a lot of history. The city holds the titles of Very Noble, Very Loyal, Very Heroic, Very Beneficent, Always Heroic and Immortal, granted mostly after its resistance against the Napoleonic army in the Sieges of Zaragoza during the War of Independence (you can see the initials of each of them on their shield). Zaragoza's main festivities are **la Virgen del Pilar** (October 12) and **San Valero** (January 29).

Big international events like "*la Expo de Zaragoza*" in 2008 focused on the water and the sustainable development, were held in the city. Also, its university was the headquarters of the United Nations Secretariat for the Water Decade 2005-2015.

Nowadays Zaragoza counts with a big touristic offer: museums, historical buildings, theaters, a charming old town, parcs, nature and a big and delicious gastronomic offer.

The cheapest and easiest way of traveling inside the city is using public transport: bus or tram. Also, you can take taxi or use alternative transport like scooters, bikes, or motorbikes.

*\*Recommendations, if you are going to take public transport, bring some cash with you, no in all the places you can pay by card (example: urban bus).*

Other ways of moving inside the city, can be by hiring a car with driver. We recommend: *Cabify* or companies like *Alquiler de vehículos Palacios* or *Procas Auto Turismos*. With these options you can book also the trip from Zaragoza 's airport to Zaragoza city.
