HOW CAN I GET THERE?

To travel from Vilnius International Airport to your hotel, you have a few convenient options:

• TAXI

Taking a taxi from Airport costs 15-20 euros and takes around 15 minutes.

• **RIDESHARING APPS**

BOLT

Taking a BOLT costs 8–13 euros and takes around 15 minutes.

UBER

Taking a UBER costs 8–13 euros and takes around 15 minutes.

*Before you embark on your journey to Vilnius, make sure to have these ridesharing apps on your phone – your travel experience will thank you!



• PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Vilnius has a well-developed public transportation system. You can take a bus from the airport to various parts of the city, including the city center where many hotels are located. To reach your hotel take bus No.88 to bus stop Aušros vartai. Bus ticket price - 0.65 Eur.


For the best experience, we recommend downloading the TRAFFI app. This app allows you to purchase tickets and view real-time bus schedules, along with the map showing bus stops.

If you are going to other places you can take train. There is a special train "Vilnius - Airport" running regularly from Vilnius railway station.

The ticket costs EUR 0.80. It can be purchased <u>online</u>, in the train and at the railway station.

WHAT TO VISIT IN VILNIUS

We created a guide about the places to visit in Vilnius that you can explore on foot.

Gediminas Castle Tower: Start your day by visiting the Gediminas Castle Tower. This iconic tower offers panoramic views of the city and the surrounding areas. You can hike up the hill or take a funicular to reach the tower.



Cathedral Square: After descending from the castle, head to Cathedral Square, the main square of Vilnius. Here, you'll find the Vilnius Cathedral with its impressive neoclassical facade and the Bell Tower. You can also visit the Cathedral Treasury and the crypt.



Vilnius Old Town: Take a stroll through the charming streets of Vilnius Old Town. This UNESCO World Heritage site is known for its well-preserved medieval

architecture, cobblestone streets, and cozy cafes. Don't miss Pilies Street, one of the oldest and most picturesque streets in the city.



Church of St. Anne: Visit the Church of St. Anne, a stunning example of Gothic architecture. Its intricate red brickwork makes it one of the most photographed buildings in Vilnius.



Užupis District: Head to the Užupis district, often referred to as the "Republic of Užupis." This bohemian neighborhood is known for its artistic vibe, unique street art,

and the Užupis Constitution, a playful declaration of independence displayed on a wall in multiple languages.



Bernardine Gardens: If you're looking for a tranquil spot, visit the Bernardine Gardens. This park is a great place to relax and enjoy nature within the city.



Gediminas Avenue or Vilnius street: Spend your evening on Gediminas Avenue, the main shopping and dining street in Vilnius. It's a great place for shopping,



enjoying a leisurely dinner, or simply people-watching.



Vilnius University: Take a leisurely stroll through the Vilnius University campus. The courtyards and buildings are steeped in history and offer a serene atmosphere.



Vilnius at Night: Wrap up your day by enjoying the city's illuminated landmarks. The Cathedral Square, Gediminas Castle Tower, and other key buildings look magical when lit up at night.
